



**PART I.**

**THERAPEUTIC INDICATIONS.**

**ACETICUM ACIDUM.**

**Labor:**

HEMORRHAGE.—*After labor.* With coldness, pallor, and difficult breathing. *With great thirst*, not relieved by drinking. Active or passive. (Outward application of vinegar to the vulva is also advised when indicated.)

GENERALITIES.—Anxiousness. Sadness. Fearful of persons and surroundings. Irritable. Delirium, alternating with unconsciousness. Head heavy, hot, with distended temporal vessels. Cold sweat on forehead. Face emaciated, pale, waxen. Cheeks flushed and hot: Hissing respiration, with rattling in larynx and trachea. Burning thirst for large quantities of water. Tfferst insatiable, not relieved by drinking. Pain in spine

headache. *Very painful* labor from a spasmodically constricted os.

CONVULSIONS.—Immediately after delivery, with intense rushing of blood to the face and head in paroxysms, making them red and hot. Rapid succession of spasms. Muscles become rigid. Piercing shrieks.

GENERALITIES.—Cannot endure warmth, must throw off all covering, and open the doors and windows, even in cold weather. Heat, throbbing and intense fulness in the head. The head is heavy, giddy, and confused with prostration. Protruding, staring eyes, and look as if glazed, in convulsions. Throbbing in ears. Sense of constriction in throat, which extends to the chest. Difficulty in breathing.

### ANTIMONIUM CRUDUM.

HEMORRHAGE.—Uterine, with distinct pressure in the womb, as if something would come out. Somewhat rheumatic.

GENERALITIES.—*While tongue*; nausea and vomiting. Fretful, peevish, *dislikes to be looked at or touched*. Great sadness and woe-ful mood. Sulky, does not wish to speak to any one.

predominates. From congestion and ulceration of the uterus. Dark flow.

HAEMORRHAGE.—With great irritation of the neck of the bladder. Almost constant desire to urinate, passing only a few drops, with cutting, burning pains during the effort.

RETAINED PLACENTA.—With a teasing to urinate; burning and almost constant desire to urinate. Burning pain in the pelvic portion of the abdomen and in the back; abdomen sensitive; feverishness; vomiting; great anguish and distress; swelling of the lips of the os uteri. Convulsions.

CONVULSIONS.—With dysuria and hydrophobic symptoms. Bright light on objects, and the sight, sound, or drinking of water, or the mere touch, seem to reproduce the spasms, which are usually violent. Renewal of spasms from touching the larynx or painful parts. Face swollen and puffy. Urine scalding, dark, and scanty, with frequent desire. Albuminuria, cylindrical casts, mucus, and shreds in urine. Vulva swollen and sensitive. With retained "folacenta or membranes, eyes bright, pupils dilated widely. Face pale and yellowish, bearing an expression of deep-seated suffering.

*first few pains.* Soon, or some days after delivery metrorrhagia, unaccompanied by plethora. Profuse; passive; with or without pain. From chlorosis or anemia.

CONVULSIONS.—Spasms, or twitchings, or fainting during labor.


AFTER-PAINS.—Mitigates after-pains.

GENERALITIES.—In the lymphatic, feeble and cachectic. With a lax tissue and languid circulation, a great tendency to hysteria, and always worse by any lifting or exertion.

## COCCULUS INDICUS.

### Labor:

Spasmodic, irregular, *paralytic pains*. Pains weak; ceasing. One hard pain, and then after a longer interval several lighter ones. Much headache. Numb, paralyzed feeling in the lower limbs, with trembling. Paralyzed weakness, worse in hips and lower limbs. Spasmodic pains in the uterus, with nausea and vomiting. Fainting. Terrible pain in the small of the back, with hour-glass contractions. Mental terror during spasmodic, irregular pains. Weak and nervous women.
